

# Basic Trip Information

## Senior Adult Program Brochure

**Departure Site:** All trips will depart from the Archdale Parks and Recreation Center located at 214 Park Drive, Archdale NC.

**Transportation:** All trips will take place on a chartered motor coach or a Parks and Recreation department bus or van. The mode of transportation will be noted on trip itineraries and flyers. Smoking is not allowed on the vehicles and we ask that smoking is done at least 100 yards away from the bus. Rest stops are made periodically throughout the trip. Seating is available on a first-come first-serve basis on the day of the trip. We are unable to accommodate special requests or reserve seats on vehicles. Seat rotation will only be used on multi-day trips.

**Escorts:** An Archdale Parks and Recreation employee will be present on all Parks and Recreation sponsored trips. Their job is to ensure that each patron's trip needs are met.

**Patron Expectation:** Trip Flyers will include expected amount of walking, including any stairs. Patrons must be able to keep to the scheduled timeline of the trip.

**Reservation Policy:** Trip Reservations are accepted on a first-come first-serve basis with payment and a completed registration form. Spaces reserved when a deposit/payment has been received. Reservations cannot be made over the phone; they must be made in person at the Recreation Center. There is no early or pre-registration available for any trip. Registration for each trip will begin 4 weeks before the date of the trip.

**Payments/Deposits:** Trip itineraries will indicate due dates for the deposit and balance. Payments can be made by check or cash only. One-day trips require a "trip payment" at reservation. The "activity payment" is required on the day of the trip. Reservations are only held with a payment.

**Trip/Activity Payment:** The trip payment is a \$5 or \$10 fee that will vary depending on the distance of the trip. The activity payment is the cost to do the activity. I.e., a trip to Reynolda house will have a \$5.00 trip fee that is due at the time of registration with a \$12.00 activity cost. The \$12.00 activity cost will pay for your ticket on the group tour.

**Cancellation Policy:** Cancellations must be made in writing at least 10 days prior to the trip departure date to receive a refund. Full or partial refunds will be made only if a replacement can be found and are subject to non-refundable expenses incurred by the department. If Archdale Parks and Recreation Department cancels a trip, a full refund will be given. No shows for trips will not receive a refund.

**Registration:** All trip participants must have a registration on file in order to attend any Parks and Recreation trip.
