



## **RESOLUTION**

### **Sewer System AIA Closeout**

**WHEREAS**, The North Carolina General Statutes Chapter 159G has created Asset Inventory and Assessment grants to assist eligible units of government with meeting their water and sewer infrastructure needs, and

**WHEREAS**, the North Carolina Department of Environmental Quality provided a State Reserve Grant in the amount of \$135,000 for Archdale to perform a sewer asset inventory and assessment and that work that has been successfully carried out and completed in accordance with the agreed scope of work, and

**WHEREAS**, the completed Asset Management Plan and Capital Improvement Plan have been presented to City Council.

**Now, therefore, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Archdale:**

1. That the City of Archdale does hereby give assurances to the North Carolina Department of Environmental Quality that the Conditions and Assurances contained in the award offers were adhered to in carrying out the project;
2. That the matching funds requirement has been met, and the City intends to requisition the remaining grant funds and closeout the project with the North Carolina Department of Environmental Quality;
3. That the City Council accepts the report as presented to City Council, and commits to utilizing the information in the ongoing management of its system;
4. That the 10-year Capital Improvement Plan developed through the study is hereby accepted and adopted by City Council.
