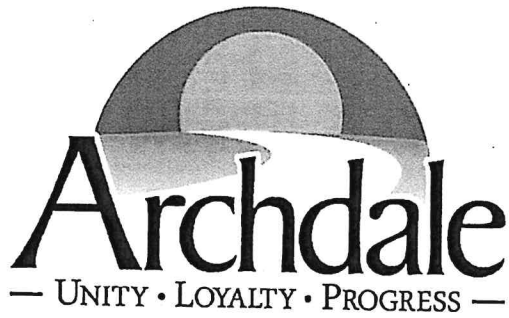
**SUBJECT:** Appointment to the Plan Archdale Committee (PAC)
