

### Fire Hydrant Testing

The Guil-Rand Fire Department (GRFD) is required to test hydrants every year for proper operation. During these flow tests, the City of Archdale and the GRFD occasionally receive inquiries regarding discolored water. This results from water rushing through the main towards the hydrant during the test.

GRFD gives notice via their Facebook page when they are testing hydrants. If you notice that your water is discolored, run your outside spigot or your bathtub for approximately 3-5 minutes to clear out the line. Do not dry washed clothes if they appear to have rust stains on them. It's better to re-wash laundry if this occurs. If you have further questions or concerns, please call

Hours of Operation are 8:00am until 5:00pm, Monday thru Saturday

Dumpsters will be available at the Public Works Yard on Old School Road for your household items such as furniture, kitchen & bathroom fixtures, wood, metal, lawnmowers, grills, etc. (All items must have fluids drained)

Free mulch is available while it lasts. Mulch will be loaded from an entrance on School Road. Mulch can be loaded 8:00 am until 5:00 pm during Spring Clean Up. Afterwards, mulch will be loaded by appointment only. Call (336) 434-7341 to schedule an appointment.

Items to be picked up curb-side: large appliances and water heaters only (all other items must be taken to the Public Works Yard on Old School Road) \*Customers need to place items at the curb. The City will pick up within two (2) weeks. (no pickups after May 4th)

We will have a separate container for the recycling of electronic items such as computers, printers, TV's, VCR and DVD players, etc.

Items we CANNOT accept:

- Oil & Oil Drums
- Paint
- Propane Tanks
- Tires
- Automotive Batteries

## Tips on Avoiding Fraud and Telephone Scams:

- Do not provide your bank account information or other personal identifying information, like your social security number, over the phone
- Your bank will not call you and request that you take your money out in the event your account is compromised. If you think there is an issue with your account, go in person.
- If the scammer is attempting to convince you that someone at the bank is involved in the compromise, come to the police department, we can assist you with verifying this allegation
- Do not provide cash to someone you do not know and ask for identification of people you meet in a business capacity ( like an ID badge)
- Do not purchase gift cards as payment for a debt or business expense.
- If someone is requesting to meet you to obtain cash or personal information and they are not willing to meet you at the Police Department or other Law Enforcement facility, that could be an indication that are attempting to defraud or deceive you.
- The Archdale Police Department is open 24/7 and can help answer questions or provide guidance if you think someone is attempting to influence you into providing money.



### **\*\*\*SCAM ALERT\*\*\***

**Recently the Archdale Police Department was notified of a scam letter that has been received by some of our Archdale citizens. We want to let our citizens know that this is NOT an official letter from our city or department nor are we requesting money for an “Emergency Bulletproof Vest Project”. If you receive this letter DO NOT respond to it or send them any money.
