



Adopt-A-Street Program

Application



Recognizing the need to combat litter concerns in our community, the Community Appearance Commission (CAC) of Archdale maintains an active “Adopt-A-Street” program. Working together with individuals, groups, and/or organizations can make a significant difference in the appearance of our community. This program will assist the City of Archdale in meeting several goals:

- Improve the attractiveness of our City
- Reduce roadway pollution
- Reduce water pollution
- Reduce stormwater drainage issues
- Increase public awareness of environmental issues
- Reduce the costs associated with litter removal

Adopt-A-Street Agreement

The Community Appearance Commission of the City of Archdale and _____

(Name of business, organization, or individual participating) recognize the need for litter-free and visually improved streets.

The Adopt-A-Street program has been established for community and civic organizations, as well as private businesses, industry, and/or individuals to contribute toward the effort of maintaining cleaner and more scenic city streets.

As indicated by their signatures on this agreement, the individual participants of the named entity are aware of the nature of the work which is to be performed and have agreed to follow the city’s rules, policies, safety guidelines, and instructions. If the above-named entity enters into a contract with a business, organization, or individual to clean the entity’s adopted section of road (‘a contracted service’), the contracted service agrees that it is aware of the nature of the work which is to be performed and has agreed to follow the city’s rules, policies, safety guidelines, and instructions. The individual participants agree to not hold the City of Archdale responsible for any injuries they, their employees, or their agents may cause or suffer as a result of participation in the program. **The participants also agree that a sign bearing the group’s name shall be installed at location to be determined by the City of Archdale after a period either of 6 months or two litter pick-ups after the date of this agreement.**

The above named entity agrees to pick-up litter **at least once every four months (January to April, May to August, and September to December)** for 3 years along its adopted section of roadway. The participant also agrees to notify the program’s coordinator prior to and upon completion of its collections. This agreement shall be valid for a minimum of 3 years, beginning ____/____/____ and ending no sooner than 3 years from that date. At the end of the contracted period, should no extension be planned, the City will remove the sign to be reused for future participants. The entity may cancel this agreement with written notice to the City of Archdale.

The City of Archdale may cancel this agreement if the above-named participant fails to meet its collection obligations for its adopted section of street. The City of Archdale shall notify the participant in writing prior to canceling this agreement and, if applicable, remove signs.

Safety Rules and Guidelines for Participants

All Participants Agree to:

- wear an Archdale supplied (or approved) safety vest
- park all vehicles clear of the roadway and on the same side of the road where volunteers will be working
- be at least 10 years of age to participate in a pick-up
- furnish adequate supervision by one or more adults 21 years of age or older for groups that have participants between the ages of 10 and 17
- pick up litter only during daylight hours
- do not pick up trash on the road surface
- conduct a safety meeting for all participants prior to each pick-up to review these Safety Rules and Guidelines

For Your Safety:

- wear light-colored clothing that covers arms and legs
- wear leather shoes or boots, gloves, hat, and safety glasses
- wear clothing that will not divert attention of motorists during pick-up
- wear clothing that will not impair vision or movement during pick-up
- work in small groups
- stay well clear of any construction
- stop work in inclement weather
- during warm weather months, drink plenty of fluids, take breaks, and avoid overexertion
- during cold weather months, dress warmly with layered clothing
- be alert for snakes, stinging insects, and poisonous plants
- do not remove hazardous substances or dead animals; notify program coordinator and give description/location of the item(s) (336-434-7333)
- avoid contact with noxious weeds and areas where herbicides were applied
- carpool to the site to reduce the number of vehicles
- use proper lifting and bending techniques

Volunteers Must Not:

- use or possess illegal drugs or alcohol during a pick-up
- pick up trash on bridges or overpasses
- pick up what appears to be hazardous materials; notify program coordinator and give description/location of the item(s) (336-434-7333)
- attempt to squeeze bags to make room for more trash; plenty of bags will be provided

In Case of Emergency:

- have an adequate first-aid kit immediately available
- select an emergency room or hospital and know the route from the work area to the designated place or treatment facility
- have transportation immediately available in case emergency situation arises

Disposal of Garbage Bags:

Follow the guidelines and instructions established by the City of Archdale which will be distributed with the supplies.

Adopt-A-Street Signs

The boxes below represent the maximum number of characters allowed on your Adopt-A-Street sign. You have the option of two lines with a possibility of 16 characters per line. Please print one letter per box (punctuation marks count as one letter). If the name of your organization can fit on one line, the sign maker will use a larger font for better visibility.

The Adopt-A-Street coordinator must approve all signs.

The City of Archdale will place your Adopt-A-Street sign at the beginning or end of your adopted street segment 6 months after signing your Adopt-A-Street agreement or after two litter pick-ups. The participant can provide input on the location of the sign, but the final determination of the sign's location will be made by the Adopt-A-Street program coordinator.

The Process for Scheduling a Litter Pick-Up

1. Once a day and time has been selected by your group, contact the Adopt-A-Street coordinator (336-434-7333) and inform him/her of your plans.
2. The City of Archdale will provide you with orange (regular trash) and blue (recycle) trash bags, gloves, and safety vests. Estimate how many of each you will need and then schedule a time and/or place to pick these items up.
3. Take a strict approach to safety during your scheduled pick-up. Please obey all rules, policies, safety guidelines, and instructions during your pick-up.
4. When a bag is full, tie it up and leave it safely off the roadway, yet visible to be picked up by Public Works employees. Otherwise, enjoy taking the time to help Archdale's Community Appearance Commission maintain a cleaner city.
5. Once your pick-up is complete, please notify the program coordinator so that the city can schedule to have the full bags picked up by City staff. Whenever possible, please return excess supplies (especially safety vests) so that they can be used in future pick-ups.
