The City of Archdale is preparing to celebrate its 7th Annual "Week for Archdale".

This is a week loaded with events and programs for the community and an opportunity for citizens to undertake fall cleaning tasks of their own. In short, it is a chance for everyone to show great pride in the place we call home.

A brief listing of this year's events includes:

Saturday Sept. 27th

- Fall Litter Sweep (7:30am - 10:00am): Join fellow members of the community for a litter sweep along select roadways in Archdale. Meeting location will be at City Hall at 7:30am. Equipment will be provided.
- Creekside parkrun: This is a free, timed 5k run/walk held every Saturday morning at 8:00am (May- Sept) in Creekside Park. Creekside parkrun has hosted over 1000 different participants and is one of only 4 parkrun events in North Carolina.
- End of Summer Bash – Enjoy the evening with music by 'Gary Lowder and the Smokin' Hot'. Enjoy end of summer weather with food trucks and listening to some good music at the park from 5:00pm - 8:00pm.

Saturday Oct 4th

- The Mayor's Walk Challenge & Creekside parkrun: This is a free, timed 5k run/walk held every Saturday morning at 9:00am (Oct to April) in Creekside Park. Creekside parkrun has hosted over 1000 different participants and is one of only 4 parkrun events in North Carolina. Join us for a morning run or walk.
- Electronics recycling event (8:00am - 12:00pm): Bring your old and/or broken electronic devices for safe and free disposal at Creekside Park. Use the Mose Drive entrance and follow the signs. No appliances or batteries can be accepted.

Week Long Happenings:

- Sept. 27th – October 4th - FREE disposal of household waste at City Yard on Old School Road. It's Fall Clean Up time! Dumpsters available 8:00am - 5:00pm for large household waste items (no paints, tires, batteries, propane tanks, etc.).
- Sept. 27th – October 4th - FREE mulch at the City yard off School Road.

Fats, Oil, & Grease

What do bacon, ice cream, and peanut butter all have in common? They are more than just tasty treats. They are also sources of fats, oil, and grease (FOG). While fats, oil, and grease add extra flavor to our food, pouring FOG down the drain can create clogs in the sewer collection system. These blockages can back up sewage into your street, yard, or home! Think of it this way – If it can clog arteries in your body, then it can also clog sewer pipes.

Fortunately, clearing up FOG is as easy as doing a few simple things around the kitchen. Pour cold fats, oil, and grease into a covered, disposable container and throw it into your garbage. Never pour fats, oil, or grease down sink drains or toilets. And, use sink strainers to catch any remaining food waste while washing dishes. Together we can avoid sewer overflows.

Loose Leaf Pick Up

Loose leaf pick up will begin on November 12, 2025. This service will continue through January 31, 2026. A leaf vacuum truck will make its way throughout the City to provide this service. Make sure loose leaves are placed near (but not in) the roadway and away from storm drains, hydrants, and utility boxes.



Limb & Brush

Limbs and brush are picked up the same week as your recycling. Place this debris at the curb (away from hydrants, mailboxes, and other utility boxes) by 7:00am on Monday of your recycling week. The City **will not** pick up limbs and/or brush left by contracted tree services.

NO PLASTIC BAGS for yard waste collection

Due to circumstances out of our control, the City can no longer collect yard waste in plastic bags. The facility where these wastes were disposed of has discontinued accepting plastic bags, and therefore we will no longer be collecting yard wastes in plastic bags. Approved paper bags will be collected.
